

Public Notice to Boil Water

Due to two (2) major water leaks that occurred on October 25, 2017 the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has required our public water system (City of Granger), PWS ID 2460002 to issue a Boil Water Notice to inform our customers that due to the presence of contaminants or an interruption in service, water from our system must be boiled prior to consumption. The area affected is City Wide. The water will be turned off on October 26, 2017 in the AM and the repairs will be done at this time. At this time we do not know how long the water will be off. Once the water is back on; you are required to boil your water until further notice. To ensure destruction of all harmful bacteria and other microbes, water for drinking, cooking, and making ice should be boiled and cooled prior to use. The water should be brought to a vigorous, rolling boil and then boiled for two minutes. In lieu of boiling, you may purchase bottled water or obtain water from some other suitable source.

When it is no longer necessary to boil the water, the water system officials will notify you that the water is safe for consumption. Instructions to discontinue boiling will be issued in the same manner as this notice.
